

Art Fair, Crafts, Vendor, and Non-Profit Guidelines for 2026
Scandia Taco Daze - Scandia Community Center
Saturday, September 12, 2026, 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Scandia Taco Daze is a community celebration in its 50th year. The vendor area is an opportunity for local artists, businesses, and non-profits to share their work with the community. The following are details:

1. The cost of a food truck space is \$125, the cost of a vendor booth is \$60 and the cost for the farmers market is \$30. There is no fee for non-profits. Vendors are welcome to purchase two booth spaces for \$120 (\$60 for the farmers market).
2. There are a limited number of spaces available; and they are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If you know you want to participate in Taco Daze as a vendor, please submit your application right away.
3. The vendor area is open from 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Your space was assigned by the Taco Daze Committee and will be clearly marked on-site. Set-up time is Saturday from 7:00-9:45 a.m. All vehicles must be out of the parking lot by 9:00 a.m. Everyone must be set-up and open from 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. The set-up is in the grassy area outside the community center and designated areas in the parking lot. Please make sure your booth space is secure. There are no early take-downs.
4. You may park in Parking Lot A across the street from the event, or in the grassy area in the south side of the even grounds. You may not move your vehicle until the event is over if you park there.
5. Participants are responsible for collecting and paying all Minnesota sales tax. Fill out and return the attached "Operator Certificate of Compliance" with your application. No application can be processed without this form completed and signed. A Minnesota tax ID number is available from the Minnesota Department of Revenue at 651-282-5225 or www.taxes.state.mn.us.
6. Participants must provide their own booth, display, and tables.
7. All artists and crafters must exhibit their own booth, display, and tables.
8. All artists and crafters must exhibit original work made by the artists - no mass-produced, franchised, or flea market items, please.
9. Food vendors must obtain all food permits prior to the day of the event. For questions, call the Washington County Department of Public Health and Environment at 651-430-6655.
10. Cancellation policy: no fees will be returned after August 1st. All cancellations must be in writing.
11. No pets are allowed. Service dogs are the only exception.
12. Bathrooms and concessions will be located nearby.
13. Taco Daze will be held rain or shine so please plan for all weather conditions. No refunds will be made for bad weather.
14. The Taco Daze Committee is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage.
15. Please clean up after yourself at the end of the day.
